If you are not using the English version of Photoshop, you can always change it to English and then back again to your native language.

## HOW TO INSTALL THE ACTION

1. Inside Photoshop, go to the 'Window' menu and select 'Actions'. A window will now appear to the right hand side.
2. Inside the Actions window, click on the top right hand corner icon to reveal the drop down menu. From here select 'Load Actions...'. Select the action which came with the download.
3. The action will now appear in the actions panel.

## HOW TO INSTALL THE BRUSHER

1. Inside Photoshop, go to the 'Window' menu and select 'Brush Presets'. A window will now appear to the right hand side.
2. Inside the Brush Presets window, click on the top right hand corner icon to reveal the drop down menu. From here select 'Load Brushes...'. Select the Brush which came with the download.
3. The Brush will now appear in the Brush panel.

## HOW TO INSTALL THE PATTERNS

1. Inside Photoshop, go to the 'Edit' menu and select 'Presets-> Presets Manager'. A window will now appear.
2. Inside the Presets window, click on the drop down menu and select 'Patterns'. From here select 'Load Patterns...'. Select the Pattern which came with the download.
3. The Patterns will now appear in the Brush panel.

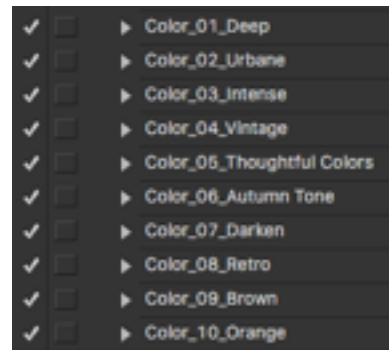


Please check:

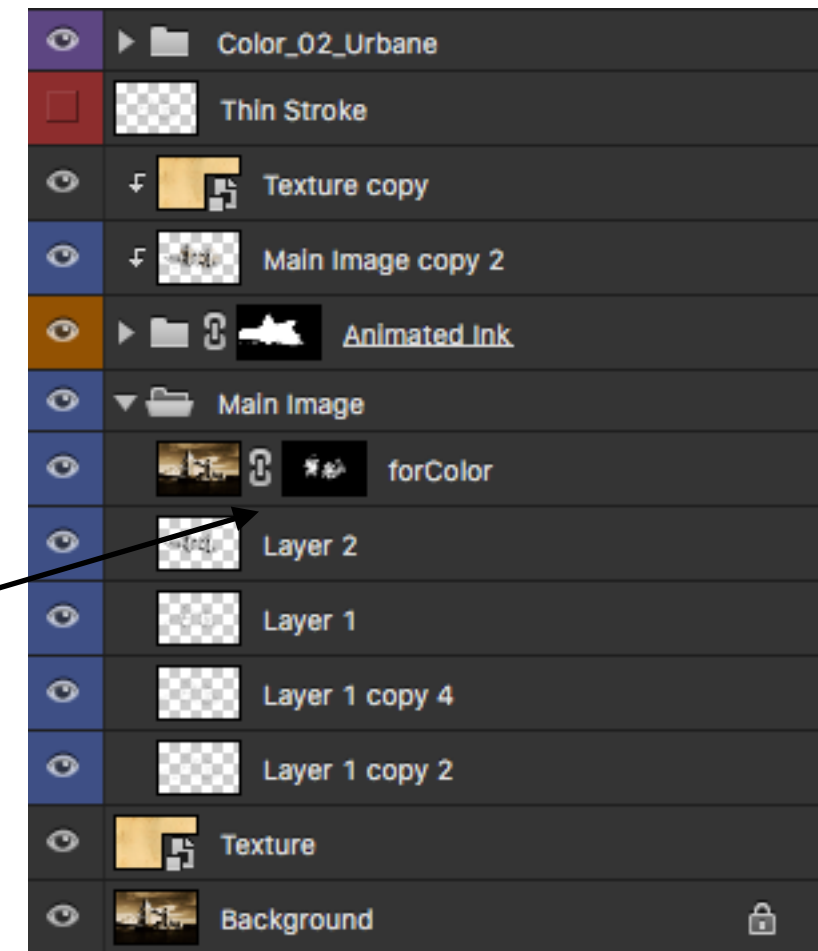
1. Your photo is in RGB color mode
2. Your photo is in 8bit color mode
3. You are running the English version of Photoshop.
4. Image has 72 Pixels/inch.

## HOW TO USE THE ACTION (Create static version)

1. Open your image
2. Create Layer with name `mask` and draw the area
3. Then play the Action `For new Image`
4. When your image are ready, you can add to some color. Draw on mask
5. Use prepared Color Effects

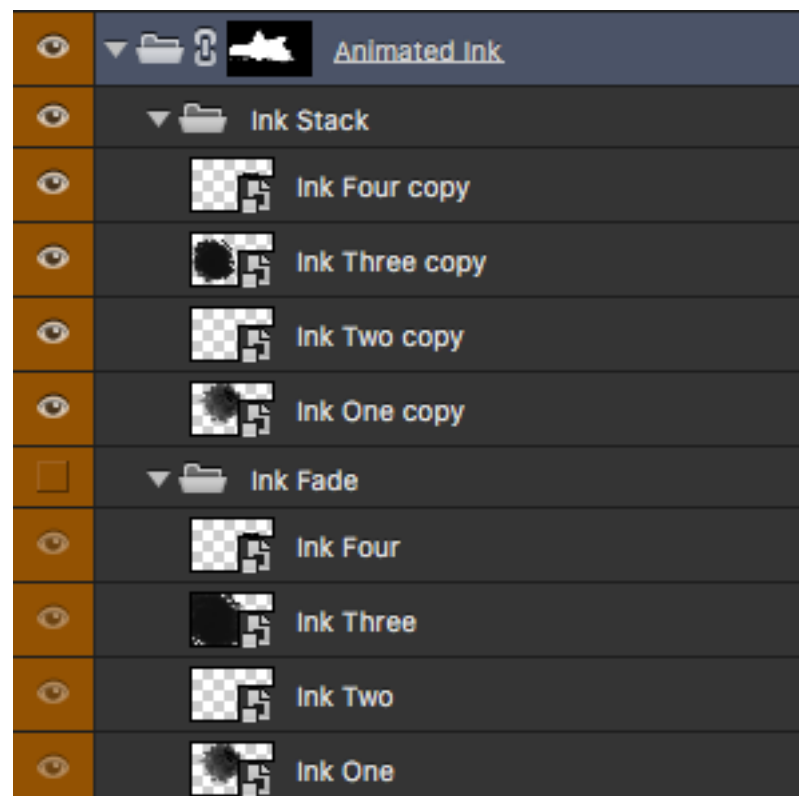
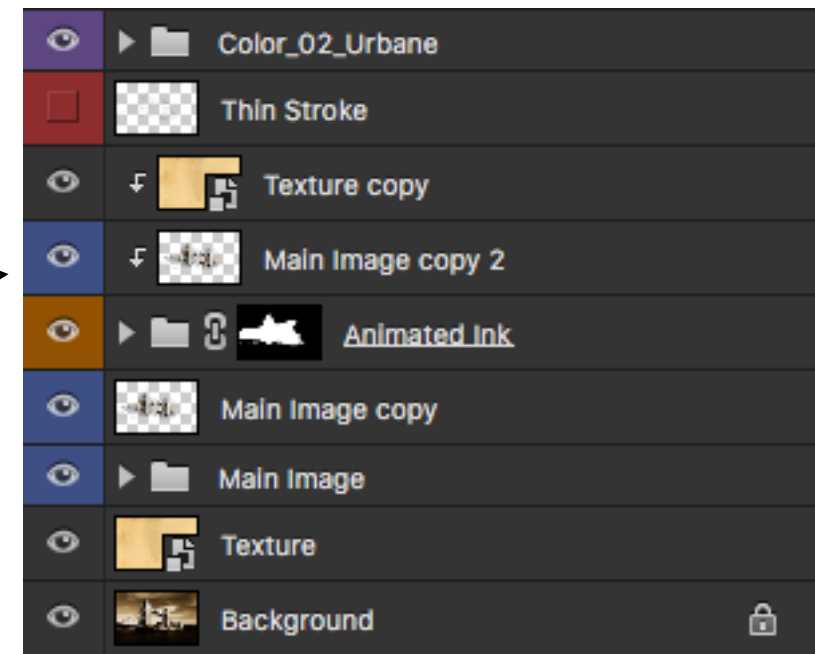


6. Save the result



## HOW TO USE THE ACTION (Create Animated version)

1. Duplicate the `Main image folder` and merge it.
2. After Replace instead this one
3. Update mask for Animated ink from the new `Main Image` that you replaced
4. Select the option of ink (Stack or fade) and Place type of ink/watercolor animation on image



5. Save the result as static or gif (For gif animation go to `File->Export->Save for web`. Select the gif format and set Looping option to Forever)
